The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.Nil at Police Station Kotwali, Patiala at the instance of respondents No.4 and 5

The present petition is disposed of with a direction that no coercive steps be taken against the petitioners and in case their arrest is required, they be released on anticipatory bail subject to the satisfaction of the arresting officer.
