The petitioner-organization is stated to be registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 and as amended from time to time. It has been averred that the members of the petitioner organization are working as handling laborers (loading and unloading) at Talwandi Bhai, District Ferozepur since 1990. The work of loading unloading of food grains under the State procurement agency is being done through the contractors.

The short prayer made in the instant petition is for directions to be issued to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the members of the petitioner organization and who apprehend a threat to the same at the hands of private respondents no.7 to 10 and who happen to be the contractors.

Having heard counsel for the petitioner organization, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the instant writ petition in terms of granting liberty to the petitioner organization to approach respondent no.3 i.e. S.S.P, Ferozepur by filing a comprehensive representation/complaint as regards their grievance/threat perception. In the eventuality of any such representation/complaint being moved by the petitioner organization, respondent no.3 i.e. S.S.P., Ferozepur would be obligated to examine the same and to thereafter take steps as he may deem fit and as warranted in accordance with law.
