The prayer in the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., is for the grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.1476, dated 04.11.2018, under Sections 407 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station City Panipat, District Panipat.

After arguing for some time and realizing that this Court is not inclined to grant any relief to the petitioner, counsel for the petitioner has stated that the petitioner would surrender and move an application for regular bail and a direction be issued to the court to decide his bail application expeditiously. I find this to be a fair request.

In the circumstances, this petition is dismissed as withdrawn. It is directed that in case the petitioner surrender before the court on or before 20.02.2019 and move an application for regular bail, it shall be decided expeditiously but in any case

by 22.02.2019.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
