Muskan and Manpreet Singh have filed this petition for directing respondents No.1 to 3 to provide adequate security and protection to their life and liberty from the hands of respondents No.4 to 6 and not to harass and implicate them falsely in any case at the instance of private respondents as the petitioners have entered the matrimonial alliances against the wishes of the parents of petitioner No.1.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Mr. Manpreet Singh Dua, Advocate has put in appearance and filed vakalatnama on behalf of respondent No.4-Dharampal (father of petitioner No.1). The parties are also present in Court, who are identified by their respective counsels.

With the intervention of Court, learned counsel for the parties agreed that father and daughter be allowed to meet. Time was granted.

Matter is taken up again.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners on instructions from their clients submits that there is no threat to their life and liberty, therefore, he seeks permission of the Court to withdraw the petition.

The prayer is accepted.

The petition is allowed to be dismissed as withdrawn.
