The petitioner company has filed the instant petition against the order dated 21.12.2018 passed by the learned Additional District Judge, Hisar and in terms of which a suit filed by the company under the Trade Marks Act, 1999, has been transferred to the Special/Commercial Court at Gurugram.

Counsel for the petitioner has been heard.

It has not been controverted that the value of the suit filed by the petitioner had been fixed at rupees two crores and accordingly a court fee amounting to Rs.20,000/- had been fixed.

In the considered view of this Court, the impugned order dated 21.12.2018 (Anenxure P-2) has been passed in terms of the Commercial Courts, Commercial Division and Commercial Appellate Division of High Courts (Amendment) Ordinance 2018 and whereunder all suits of commercial transactions valued at rupees one crore or excess have to be

tried by the Commercial Courts.

There is no infirmity in the impugned order.

Petition is dismissed.
