AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.205 dated 15.09.2015 registered under Sections 302, 323, 148, 149, 120-B IPC at Police Station Kotwali, Patiala, District Patiala.

The allegation against the petitioner was of murder.

Learned Sr. Deputy Advocate General has stated that only 2 witnesses remains to be examined who are doctors and the same will be examined on or before 14.06.2019 and till such time bail should not be granted to the petitioner.

I find this to be a fair submission. In the circumstances, in view of the undertaking given by the learned Sr. Deputy Advocate General, it is

directed that in case the prosecution does not lead its entire evidence on or before 14.06.2019 (subject to the accused not obstructing the same), the petitioner be released on bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
