Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect their life and liberty from the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 8 as they have solemnized marriage on 13.01.2019 against the wishes of private respondents.

Learned State counsel apprised the Court that the statements of respondents have been recorded and same have been filed in the Court which are taken on record. Copy thereof has been handed over to learned counsel for the petitioners. In the statement of respondent Nos.4, 6, 8 (brothers of petitioner No.1), it is revealed that they have no objection to the alleged marriage. Further statement of father of petitioner No.2 also has been recorded and he stated that the petitioners are happily residing. This fact is not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioners.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the petition.
