By way of fling this petition, the petitioners pray for entrusting the investigation pertaining to FIR No.291 dated 12.10.2018 registered at Police Station Adampur, District Hisar under Sections 306, 509 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860, to some senior police officer of the rank of Superintendent of Police or to transfer the investigation to some other District except District Hisar.

The learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the brother of the petitioners had committed suicide and that a suicide note (Annexure P-4) had been found indicting his wife Smt. Sudesh. It has further been submitted that statement of daughter of the deceased has also been recorded in terms of Section 164 Cr.P.C., wherein also she has specifically stated that her mother Smt. Sudesh was responsible for abetting suicide of his father. The learned counsel has submitted that despite there being clinching evidence, the investigation is not being conducted properly as a

politician of the ruling party namely Subhash Barala, State President BJP, Haryana is a close relative of the accused Smt. Sudesh.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioners, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Inspector General of Police, Hisar Range, Hisar to look into the matter and to dispose of the representation (Annexure P-7), moved by petitioner No.1, in accordance with law and to ensure that the matter is investigated fairly and expeditiously and is investigated by an officer not below the rank of Superintendent of Police, who shall regularly keep respondent No.3-Inspector General of Police, Hisar Range, Hisar updated regarding the progress made in the matter.

A copy of this order alongwith representation (Annexure P-7) be sent to respondent No.3-Inspector General of Police, Hisar Range, Hisar so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
