This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ, in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.2 to use the fund @ ₹932.44 Lakhs (206.78 Lakhs), granted to respondent No.2 by respondent No.1 for the construction of road, sewerage system, electricity poles etc.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage, he would be satisfied, if this petition be treated as representation and a direction is issued to respondent No.2-Executive Officer, Municipal Council, Malerkotla to consider and decide the same expeditiously.

Heard.

A complete set of paper book has been handed over to Mr. Navdeep Chhabra, D.A.G., Punjab in the Court today.

In view of the above, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to submit a copy of the present petition within two weeks from today to respondent No.2- Executive Officer, Municipal Council, Malerkotla who shall treat the copy of present petition as representation and to consider and decide the same within six weeks from the receipt of the certified copy of the judgment. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the request made by the petitioner is admissible to him, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the request made by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
