1. Challenge in this revision petition is to the orders dated 08.05.2018, 19.07.2018 and 06.10.2018 passed by Additional District Judge, Charkhi Dadri and Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Charkhi Dadri respectively.

2. On 22.10.2018, notice of motion was issued only to the extent of exploring amicable settlement between the parties. Thereafter, learned counsel for the petitioner argued the case on merits on 30.04.2019 on the basis of amendment in High Court Rules and Orders. The amendment in question may give rise to arguable points in the facts and circumstances of the case.

3. On 28.05.2019, during course of arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner showed readiness on the part of the petitioner to pay lump sum amount of Rs.4 lacs towards full and final settlement of claim of the respondents. Learned counsel for the respondents sought time to have further instructions.

4. Today, both the parties are *ad idem* that a total amount of Rs.5,50,000/- would suffice to serve the purpose of full and final settlement of the claim of the respondents.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes on behalf of the petitioner to pay the amount in a sum of Rs.5,50,000/- by way of demand draft to respondent No.3 within four weeks from today.

6. In view of above, this revision petition is disposed of.

7. In case the aforesaid commitment is not honoured, this revision petition would be deemed to be dismissed without making any further reference to the Court.
