This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ of Mandamus directing the respondents for taking appropriate action on the complaint/representation dated 15.12.2018 (Annexures P-4 and P-6).

A complete set of paper book has been handed over to Mr. Navdeep Chhabra, DAG, Punjab, in the Court today.

Without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1-Director, Rural Development and Panchayat, Punjab, Vikas Bhawan, Sector 62, SAS Nagar (Mohali), to consider and decide the representations dated 15.12.2018 (Annexures P-4 and P-6), within six weeks from the receipt of the certified

copy of the judgment after giving an effective opportunity of hearing to the petitioner. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to him, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
