This is a civil revision that has been filed seeking to challenge the order of the Rent Controller dated 11.07.2017 by which eviction has been ordered of the petitioner herein. The order of eviction was challenged by the petitioner before the Appellate Authority and the appeal was dismissed by an order dated 07.08.2018. Aggrieved, the instant civil revision has been filed.

On 17.01.2019, counsel for the petitioner had submitted that petitioner-tenant Santokh Singh would be interested in buying the tenanted premises at the market rate and it was on this limited issue that notice was issued for today.

As per office report, notices could not be issued for want of process fee. Counsel for the petitioner is also not present in the court today, despite the matter having been called twice. It appears that the petitioner is

not serious in the offer that was made. This court has gone through the well reasoned orders passed by the courts below and does not find any illegality or infirmity in the concurrent findings recorded by them.

In view of the above, the civil revision in hand is hereby dismissed.
