Both the counsel for the parties have produced the order dated 30.09.2019 passed by the apex Court in SLP No. 24466 of 2019. In the said order the following observations were made:-

“Considering the nature of grievance made by both sides, we deem it appropriate to stay the operation of impugned judgement and permit the petitioner-State Bank of India to proceed with the sale process in respect of the subject residential property in accordance with law. That be done within eight weeks from today.

In view of this order, nothing would survive for consideration in the writ petition which is pending before the High Court.

The parties are free to bring this order to the notice of the High Court, so that no further order need be passed by it in the pending writ petition until this so directs

List the matter after eight weeks.”

In view of the aforesaid, counsel for the petitioner submits that this petition has become infructuous and prays for withdrawal of the same.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
