The instant Revision Petition has been filed for setting aside the impugned order dated 19.03.2018 (Annexure P-7) passed by the Additional Civil Judge (SD) Meham.

Notice of motion was issued on 26.10.2018 on the premise that filing of replication to the counter-claim was declined by the Trial Court on the ground that issues have already been framed and even 04 prosecution witnesses were examined at that stage.

Today, Mr. Ashwani Bakshi, Advocate appearing on behalf of respondent No.2 states that the suit and the counter-claim have been decided by the learned Trial Court on merits vide judgment and decree dated 12.07.2019 passed by the Additional Civil Judge (Sr. Division) Meham, District Rohtak. The suit filed by the plaintiff was decreed and the counter-claim set up by the defendant was dismissed with costs.

In view of of aforesaid factual position, this Revision Petition has become infructuous.
