Mr. Rajan Bansal, Advocate appears for the respondents.

It is informed that the appeal filed by the present petitioner challenging his eviction ordered by the learned Rent Controller has since been dismissed by the learned Appellate Authority, Bathinda on 11.01.2019.

Learned counsel for the respondents thus prays that the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

However, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the question of the rate of *mesne* profits would still be alive for adjudication by this Court.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties, I do not find any ground to continue with the present proceedings after the dismissal of the petitioner's appeal by the learned Appellate Authority.

Present revision petition is accordingly dismissed.

Needless to say, the petitioner shall be at liberty to challenge the rate of *mesne* profits, in proceedings if any, which may be initiated to challenge decision dated 11.01.2019 by the learned Appellate Authority, Bathinda.

The amount deposited by the petitioner pursuant to order dated 26.10.2018 be, however, released to the respondents along with interest, if any, which may have accrued.
