For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed. Date of hearing of the main case is preponed for today.

Main Case

[1]. Petitioner has assailed the order dated 20.10.2018 passed by the Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.) Gurugram in Insolvency Petition titled '*S.E. Investments Limited vs. Smt. Padmini Galgotia*' vide which the evidence of the defendant was closed by order of the Court.

[2]. At the time of issuance of notice of motion on 26.10.2018, learned counsel for the petitioner contended that one opportunity be granted to the defendant/petitioner for leading entire evidence subject to payment of adequate costs.

Till the next date of hearing, trial Court was directed to adjourn the proceedings beyond the date fixed by this Court.

[3]. Thereafter, Mr. Kamal Sehgal, Advocate appeared on behalf of the respondent and submitted that one opportunity be given to the defendant forthwith in order to avoid any further delay in disposal of the suit.

[4]. Notice of the application was issued for 20.12.2018 for final disposal. On 20.12.2018, the application could not be taken up and the same was adjourned for today.

[5]. Keeping in view the statement made by learned counsel for the respondent, this revision petition is disposed of by granting one opportunity to the defendant/petitioner to conclude her entire evidence on the date already fixed by the trial Court, however subject to payment of costs of Rs.10,000/- to be paid to the plaintiff.

[6]. The trial Court shall make every endeavour to dispose of the suit at the earliest. Payment of costs shall be condition precedent for granting indulgence by the trial Court in the aforesaid context.
