In this revision petition, the petitioner is aggrieved with the avoidable delay stated to have been occasioned in his Execution Application, pending before the Ld. Civil Judge (Junior Division), Amritsar.

2. From the copies of the *Zimni* Orders (Annexure P-6) attached along with the present revision, it is seen that the execution matter first came up before the Ld. Court below on 31st August, 2013, after which objections were filed on behalf of the Judgment Debtors to which the Decree Holders filed their reply on 21st January, 2017, and that matter still remains pending.

3. Thereafter on 17th March, 2017, an application was filed on behalf of the Decree Holders for issuing the original FDR to them to

which the Judgment Debtors filed their reply on 30th May, 2017. But till date no orders even on that application have been passed.

4. After perusing the series of *Zimni* Orders passed since the initial stage of the Execution case, in the opinion of this Court, the manner in which the matter has been taken up by the Ld. Court below is rather mechanical and pedestrian.

5. As such, without issuing any notice upon the Judgment Debtors, the present petition is disposed off at this stage with a direction upon the Ld. Executing Court to decide the applications pending before it, as expeditiously as possible, and preferably within three months from the date of communication of this order.
