This petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 452 dated 23.09.2018, registered under Sections 170, 406, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the IPC at Police Station Sector 14, Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner intends to settle the dispute with the complainant/victim and he undertakes to deposit ₹2.5 Lakh with the Illaqua Magistrate/trial Court at the time of furnishing bail/surety bonds.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that even on 21.09.2018, the petitioner has paid an amount of ₹2 Lakh to one of the victims and he is ready to deposit the balance amount of ₹2.5 Lakh with the Illaqua Magistrate/trial Court, to be paid to the victim concerned.

Learned counsel, on instructions from the parents of the petitioner, who are present in Court, submits that the aforesaid amount will be deposited within a period of three days.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Trilok Singh and on the basis of the custody certificate filed today in Court, has not disputed the factual position that there are two victims from whom the petitioner has taken ₹2 Lakh and ₹2.5 Lakh, respectively.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, considering the fact that the petitioner is exploring the possibility of some settlement with the complainant/victims and he is ready to deposit the amount of ₹2.5 Lakh with the Illaqua Magistrate/trial Court, this petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Illaqua Magistrate/trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned and on deposit of ₹2.5 Lakh which will be paid to the victim concerned.
