Service upon the respondent has been effected through his father.

Heard, learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the impugned order in which she had been granted alimony *pendente lite* @ Rs.20,000/- per month apart from Rs.10,000/- as litigation expenses to defend the original petition, under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, filed against her by the respondent.

A perusal of the documents filed, including the Income Tax Returns of the respondent for the assessment years 2015-2016 onwards upto 2018-2019, which period covers the date when the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act was filed, it would appear that lastly the income of the respondent was in the range of Rs.1.20 lakhs to Rs.1.25 lakhs, per month.

Consequently, the revision petition is disposed off and the impugned order is modified to the extent that the petitioner shall be entitled to alimony *pendente lite* @ Rs.35,000/- per month and litigation expenses are quantified at Rs.25,000/-, instead of the amounts awarded by the Ld. Court below.
