The petitioner is seeking regular bail in case FIR No. 321, dated 29.10.2018 , under Sections 399 and 402 IPC, registered at Police Station 11, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner in the FIR are that he along with co-accused was planning to rob the petrol pump. Learned counsel further contends that the petitioner is 22 years of age and is not involved in any other case. He is in custody for about 06 months.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Jagroop Singh states that datar has been recovered from the petitioner and he was arrested on the spot. However, he is not in a position to controvert the submission of learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner was only preparing to commit robbery and no further steps in the direction for commission of the offence were taken by the petitioner.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is in custody for about 6 months, I deem it to be a fit case to grant him the concession of regular bail as the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on her furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
