There would be no ground to review order dated 1.2.2018, particularly when the learned counsel for the review applicant has been unable to offset the specific finding recorded regarding similar employees getting the benefit which has been offered to the workman. Considering this aspect the plea of parity raised by the respondent is justified. This implies that even if an argument of the learned counsel for the appellant has to be accepted, assuming so, he would not be able to wriggle out of this particular aspect which would lead to an inescapable conclusion of the entitlement of the respondent to the benefit granted to him by virtue of the impugned order. That apart instant application is barred by delay of 326 days in filing which has not been explained satisfactorily. Hence, dismissed.
