The present writ petition has been filed by the petitioners for increase of the fixed medical allowance as increased by the respondents-State vide Notification dated 03.07.2018 (Annexure P-2).

As per the said Notification dated 03.07.2018 (Annexure P-2), fixed medical allowance, which was ₹500/- has been increased to ₹1000/- w.e.f. 01.05.2018. The petitioners have alleged that despite the said increase, they are still being paid only ₹500/- each, though they are entitled for the fixed medical allowance of ₹1000/- w.e.f. 01.05.2018.

For the relief, which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioners have served upon the respondents a legal notice dated 05.11.2018 (Annexure P-3) and as per the averments made in the writ petition, the said legal notice is still pending consideration with the respondents.

Without going into the merits of the case or expressing any opinion to the entitlement of the petitioners in respect of the claim prayed in the present writ petition or in the legal notice, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to pass an appropriate speaking order on the claim raised by the petitioners in the legal notice dated 05.11.2018 (Annexure P-3) within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case after the order, it is found by the respondents that the petitioners are entitled for any monetary benefits, the same should also be released to them within a period of next three months.

The writ petition stands disposed of.
