In the present writ petition, the prayer of the petitioner is that against the order dated 05.07.2018 by which 10% cut in the pension for one year was imposed, the petitioner has filed a statutory appeal on 25.07.2018 (Annexure P-3).

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that though a period of approximately six months have passed but the said appeal has not been decided by the respondents and the petitioner is being caused prejudice in view of no decision for the reason that the less pension is being paid to him.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Deepali Puri, Addl. A.G., Punjab, present in the Court, accepts notice. Requisite copies of the petition be supplied to her during the course of the day.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State has no objection in case the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction that the appeal dated 25.07.2018 filed by the petitioner (Annexure P-3) be decided in a time bound manner.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide Annexure P-3 i.e. the appeal filed by the petitioner against the order dated 05.07.2018 if not already decided within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.
