Challenge in the instant petition is to the order dated 29.07.2018 (Annexure P-6) issued by the Section Officer (Correction Cell) under the Central Board of Secondary Education and whereby request of the petitioner for correction of his parent's name in the 10+2 certificate has been declined.

Case of the petitioner is that his father's name is Ajay Kumar and mother's name is Veeran Wali whereas names mentioned in the 10+2 certificate are Ajay Kumar Verma and Vimmy Verma.

Perusal of the impugned order dated 29.07.2018 (Annexure P-6) reveals the basis of rejection of request of the petitioner to be that the school records does not support the desired correction.

It is not in dispute that the petitioner was a student of Police DAV Public School, PAP Campus, Jalandhar Cantt. while appearing in the 10+2 examination.

A specific query was put to counsel as to whether the changes prayed for in the instant petition stand incorporated in the school records. No

definite response is forthcoming. Counsel however refers to communication dated 29.03.2018 (Annexure P-5) in terms of which the school in question had forwarded the request for correction in mother's name and father's name to the CBSE Authorities.

In the considered view of this Court, the communication dated 29.03.2018 (Annexure P-5) does not bring forth as to whether the school records have been updated in terms of the prayer and correction sought for in the instant petition.

The petitioner ought to in the first instance approach the school to make the necessary changes and to get the school records updated.

As such while declining to interfere in the instant petition, liberty is granted to the petitioner to approach the school in question and upon the necessary correction being incorporated in the school records, to approach the concerned authorities under the CBSE to carry out changes in the 10+2 certificate as well.

Disposed of.
