In the present writ petition, the prayer has been made by the petitioners for counting the service which they have rendered with HSMITC and UHBVNL from 14.06.1978 to 06.11.1988 and 07.11.1988 to 16.05.1992 respectively as a qualifying service while calculating/fixing the pensionary benefits.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that for the relief which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioners have served the respondents with a representation dated 10.09.2018 (Annexure P-7) and they will be satisfied at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation dated 10.09.2018 (Annexure P-7) by passing a speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioners for the relief which has been claimed by them in the representation dated 10.09.2018 (Annexure P-7), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the representation dated 10.09.2018 (Annexure P-7) within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, it is found that the petitioners are entitled to any monetary benefits after the decision of the representation, the same should also be paid to them within three months thereafter.
