INDERJIT SINGH, J. (Oral)

This order shall dispose of CRM-M-3812-2019, filed by petitioner-Rinku and CRM-M-3825-2019, filed by petitioner-Rajiv, under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.675 dated 19.10.2018, registered at Police Station Samalkha, District Panipat, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 326 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code.

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Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested these petitions.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

The present petitioners have been in custody since 21.10.2018. No grievous injury is attributed to them. A cricket wicket has been recovered from petitioner-Rajiv whereas a *gandasi* has been recovered from petitioner-Rinku. The petitioners are not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as they are in judicial custody. The trial of case may take a long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioners in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, these criminal miscellaneous petitions are allowed and the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail subject to their furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount each to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
