AMIT RAWAL, J. (Oral)

The present civil revision is directed against the impugned orders Annexures P-1 and P-2, whereby the ad-interim application of the petitioner-plaintiff in a suit for permanent injunction seeking restraint against the respondent-defendants from forcible interference into peaceful possession, dispossession and encroachment of any part of the residential house, has been dismissed.

This Court, while issuing notice of motion on 10.11.2017 passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that initially interim injunction was granted in favour of the plaintiff and thereafter it was vacated on the ground that the plaintiff claims possession on the basis of alleged title arising out of the agreement to sell.

Learned counsel further contends that defendant No.3

has the similar possessory title and in view thereof, the trial Court should have ordered status quo between the parties.

Notice of motion for 16.03.2018.

In the meanwhile, status quo regarding possession over the suit property be maintained by the parties.”

Mr. M.S.Kohli, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the suit is slated for 18.03.2019 for plaintiff's evidence.

Without commenting on the merits and de-merits of the case, by upholding the ad-interim order dated 10.11.2017, I dispose of the present revision petition with a direction that the plaintiff shall avail three effective opportunities, whereas defendants four effective opportunities and the trial Court shall make an endeavour to dispose of the suit within a period of one year.
