The petitioner is a Cooperative and Labour Construction Society.

In para 2 of the writ petition details of various work orders issued in favour of the petitioner/Society by the Punjab Water Resources Management and Development Corporation have been furnished.

The short grievance raised in the instant petition is that inspite of the work having been completed and executed to the satisfaction of the authorities concerned, a payment of Rs.60 lakhs approximately is still due and the same has been withheld without any justifiable basis.

Counsel submits that he would be satisfied if the instant petition was to be disposed of with a direction to the respondent/authorities to examine the claim of the petitioner against the backdrop of a legal notice dated 20.11.2018 (Annexure P-6) that has already been served.

Submission made by counsel is found to be just and reasonable.

Without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the instant writ petition with a direction to respondent Nos.3 and 4 to examine the claim of the petitioner/

Society and to take a final decision on the legal notice dated 20.11.2018 (Annexure P-6) expeditiously and in any case within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of a certified copy of this Court.

Needless to mention that if any payment is found due to the petitioner, the same would be released without any further delay.
