The petitioner-husband has preferred the instant petition under Section 401 Cr.P.C., against the order dated 18.12.2018, passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Yamunanagar at Jagadhari in application under Section 12 of the Protection of women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 (43 of 2005), moved by the respondent-wife, vide which the petitioner was directed to pay Rs.2,000/- per month as interim maintenance to respondent from the date of application.

It has been argued that in another petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C., filed by the respondent, the petitioner was also directed to pay Rs.2,000/- per month as interim maintenance to the respondent from the date of application.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is earning Rs.8,000/- per month.

To the mind of this Court Rs.2,000/- is highly on the meagre side. If he pays 50% of the salary to the respondent even then there is no

scope of alteration in the impugned order.

As such, finding no merit in the instant petition, the same is dismissed.
