Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the claim of the petitioner was rejected by the orders Annexures P-4, P-5 and P-6 dated 08.02.2017, 10.03.2017 and 07.06.2017 respectively, still by a subsequent order dated 24.12.2018 (Annexure P-9), the respondents have found that the petitioner was entitled for the benefit as being claimed in the present writ petition and the reason given in the rejection order was factually incorrect.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the legal notice which the petitioner has submitted for grant of the said benefits dated 15.12.2018 (Annexure P-8) is still pending consideration and therefore, in view of latest stand conveyed to the petitioner vide order dated 24.12.2018, the appropriate decision has not been taken so far by the respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage in case the respondents are directed to decide the legal notice dated 15.12.2018 (Anneuxre P-8).

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Let respondent No.2 take a decision on the legal notice served by the petitioner within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

However, it is made clear that this Court expresses no opinion on the merits of the case and the entitlement of the petitioner for grant of benefit as being claimed by the petitioner in the present writ petition or in the legal notice.
