In the present writ petition, the grievance raised by the petitioner is to grant him the benefit as enumerated in para 26 of Punjab National Bank (Employees') Pension Regulation, 1995.

In response to the representation filed, the petitioner has been informed on 19.12.2018 (Annexure P-8) that they are yet to get the proof of appointment of the petitioner as Agriculture Officer so as to grant him the benefit of additional notional service under Regulation 1995.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the last more than one and half year, only the correspondence is being done with the Head Office by the respondents but there are no instructions, which are being received by the Bank from the Head Office and the petitioner is already 72 years of age.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 1 to pass appropriate orders on the claim

made by the petitioner with respect to the grant of benefit of Punjab National Bank (Employees') Pension Regulation, 1995 within a period of three months from the receipt of copy of this order.
