Status report dated 08.02.2019 has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record. A copy thereof has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

According to the status report, an inquiry has been conducted by the Superintendent of Police (Traffic), S.A.S. Nagar (Mohali) and according to the said inquiry, none of the accused in the FIR has been found innocent. The concerned SHO has been directed to proceed further in accordance with law.

In view of the averments made in the status report, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition has been rendered infructuous and same may be disposed of as such.

At this stage, Mr. Dharminder, Advocate puts in appearance on behalf of respondent No. 6 and submits that the FIR is collusive in nature and the petitioner has not been inducted as tenant by him, although he is owner of the property. The complainant and the petitioner are colluding with one another to dispossess his client although he is in settled possession.

The petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. In case, respondent No. 6 has any grievance, he can avail of any other appropriate remedy available to him under the law.
