Aarzoo Gill (minor) has filed the instant petition through her father and natural guardian seeking issuance of a Writ of Certiorari for quashing and setting aside a list of children who have been selected for the Lawn Tennis team to represent U.T. Chandigarh for the 64th National School Games Championship (Under 19 age group) and to be held at Mumbai (Maharashtra).

Counsel for the petitioner has been heard at length.

The instant writ petition raises questions of facts and allegations in the nature of fixing matches during the course of trial/selection, "players passing on their matches" to other players so as to facilitate selection of their friends, improper schedule of the Lawn Tennis Selection Camp, coaches not being familiar with the rules and regulations of the game etc.

For determination and examination of such allegations/issues evidence would have to be led.

At this stage, counsel prays for withdrawal of the instant petition with liberty to avail of any other civil remedy that may be available to the petitioner in accordance with law.

Prayer is allowed.

Disposed of as withdrawn with the liberty, as prayed for.
