GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

1. Petitioners – Shalini Mishra and Suraj Kumar have averred that they have married against wishes of respondents no.4 and 5, who are father and brother of petitioner No.2. Petitioner No.1 has annexed copy of her duly sworn affidavit to the effect that she is aged 18 years and petitioner No.2 has annexed copy of AADHAR card indicating his age as 21 years.
2. The petitioners apprehend threat to their life and liberty at the hands of respondents no.4 & 5 and thus seek issuance of appropriate directions.

3. The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to look into the representation (Annexure P-5) made by petitioners, in accordance with law, immediately upon receipt of certified copy of this order. In case any serious apprehension of threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners is found, requisite steps be taken immediately, in accordance with law, to protect life and liberty of the petitioners.
4. However, the aforesaid order shall not be taken to be any expression regarding validity of the alleged marriage of the parties.
