Both the above mentioned petitions under Section 438 of the Criminal Procedure Code have been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to petitioners Bhupinder Singh alias Phinda, Happy, Ranjit Kaur and Inderjit Kaur, in case F.I.R. No.125 dated 14.11.2018 under Sections 307, 353, 186, 332, 232, 341, 324, 148, 149, 427 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Kathgarh, District SBS Nagar.

Reply by way of affidavit of Raj Pal Singh, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Balachaur, filed on behalf of respondent-State, is taken on record.

Having considered the nature of injuries caused to Palwinder Singh, specifically injury No.1 i.e. incised wound on the head with sharp-edged weapon and injury No.2 i.e. incised wound and other injuries to injured persons and the fact that even recovery of weapon has not been effected as yet, no case is made out for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Resultantly, both the petitions are dismissed.
