The present order shall dispose of two petitions being CR-7914-2017 - "Satwinder Singh vs. Dalwinder Kaur" and CR-7918-2017 - "Satwinder Singh vs. Dalwinder Kaur." These petitions arise out of a common order dated 22.08.2017 passed by the Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), SAS Nagar (Mohali) (for short-the Trial Court) through which while adjudicating upon two applications -one filed by the petitioner-

husband and the other by the respondent-wife under Section 24 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, the application filed by the petitioner-husband has been dismissed while the application filed by respondent-wife has been allowed resulting in the award of ₹5,000/-per month by the petitioner-husband to the respondent-wife and the minor child of the parties who is in the custody of the respondent-wife.

The case set up by the respondent-wife before the Trial Court was that the petitioner owned agricultural land and was also running a Poultry Farm and was thus earning over ₹1,00,000/- per month. It was further submitted that due to differences between the parties their dispute was taken up before the Panchayat where the petitioner had agreed to pay to her an amount of ₹200/-per day.

Through the order impugned in the present proceedings the Trial Court has directed payment of ₹5,000/-per month to the respondent and the minor child of the parties who admittedly is living with the respondent. In the light of above facts, the awarded maintenance is found to be just and reasonable.

Resultantly both the petitions filed by the petitioner-husband being CR No.7914 of 2017 and CR No.7918 of 2017 are dismissed.
