This order of mine shall dispose of two revision petitions bearing **CR No.8408 of 2016** titled as **“Daya Ram and another V/s Nirmala Rao”**, arising out of the Civil Suit No.127 of 2015 filed by Nirmala Rao against the petitioner-Daya Ram, wherein the application for grant of interim stay, dismissed by the trial Court, has been allowed by the lower Appellate Court and second petition bearing **CR No.1688 of 2017** titled as

**CR No.8408 of 2016 (O&M) and
CR No.1688 of 2017 (O&M)**

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“Sarwati and another V/s Nirmala Rao and another”, arising out of the Civil Suit No.168 of 2015, wherein the application for relief of injunction has been dismissed by both the Courts below.

Both the revision petitions were preferred against the impugned order dated 03.10.2016 (Annexure P-3).

This Court had, vide order dated 21.12.2016 in CR No.8408 of 2016 and 06.07.2018 in CR No.1688 of 2017, while issuing notice of motion, granted the *status quo* regarding possession over the suit property.

Mr. Viren Jain, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent(s) submitted that both the suits have reached at the final stage of arguments.

In view of above, without commenting upon the merit and demerit of the matter, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the revision petitions. However, *status quo* order shall continue, till the adjudication of the suits.
