This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., for quashing of FIR No. 162 dated 10.09.2012, under Section 420 of Indian Penal Code 1860, registered at Police Station City Moga, District Moga (Annexure P-1) and all other consequential proceedings qua the petitioner on the basis of compromise.

Pursuant to the order dated 30.01.2019, the parties had appeared before the learned Additional District and Sessions Judge, Moga, who has submitted the report stating that the compromise has been entered into by the parties without any inducement, threat, promise, undue pressure, coercion, fear, undue influence and out of their free will.

In view thereof, this petition is allowed. FIR No. 162 dated

10.09.2012, under Section 420 of Indian Penal Code 1860, registered at Police Station City Moga, District Moga (Annexure P-1) and all other consequential proceedings qua the petitioner, are quashed.
