This application for transfer of divorce petition titled 'Harpreet Singh Vs. Satwant Kaur and another', pending in the Court of Addl. District Judge, Panchkula to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhri, has been filed by applicant Satwant Kaur, aged about 30 years, estranged wife of respondent No.1 Harpreet Singh, residing separately from him on account of differences between the spouses.

According to the applicant, she is residing separately from respondent No.1, who has filed a divorce petition against her on false allegations. It is difficult for her to travel from Yamuna Nagar to Panchkula to attend the dates of hearing in the Court there. Therefore, the present application be accepted.

Notice of the application was given to the respondents but they did not appear to offer a contest.

I have heard learned counsel for the applicant besides going through the record.

The applicant herself has placed on file copy of the divorce petition, a perusal of which goes to show that her husband Harpreet Singh, who is respondent No.1 in the application, has levelled serious allegations against moral character of the present applicant, referring to obscene video clips sent by respondent No.2 Ravinder to respondent No.1 Satwant Kaur, who is applicant before this Court and some messages and videos were also exchanged between two of them and that she had admitted her illicit relations with respondent No.2 Ravinder before marriage.

Under the circumstances, keeping in view the nature of allegations, the application cannot be accepted. The same stands dismissed accordingly.
