G.S. SANDHAWALIA, J.

The above-captioned two revision petitions are directed against the order passed by the Executing Court dated 11.08.2014 whereby Additional District Judge, Fazilka has dismissed the claim for enhanced compensation as per the award dated 13.11.2007. The landowners had claimed 50% on account of *solatium*.

The award as such has been modified by a detailed judgment of even date passed in **RFA No.3133 of 2008 'State of Punjab & Anr. vs. Surinder Ahuja & Anr.'**.

Resultantly, the revision petitions are disposed of having been rendered infructuous wherein it has been clarified that *solatium* would only be 30% as statutorily provided and the landowners would be entitled for severance @ 40%.

Resultantly, revision petitions are disposed of as infructuous with liberty to the landowners to claim their balance amount, if any, in view of the modification done vide the above said appeal.

Ordered accordingly.
