By way of filing this petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of necessary directions to official respondents to look into grievance of petitioner and to conduct fair investigation and legal action against the private respondents, in accordance with law.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that his wife Navdeep Kaur (now deceased) had been administered poison by the private respondents resulting in her death and that it is in fact a case of honour-killing, as said Navdeep Kaur had married the petitioner against wishes of her parents. It has further been submitted that although a representation (Annexure P-2) had been submitted in this regard to Senior Superintendent of Police, Mohali, but no action has been taken thereupon.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, S.A.S. Nagar (respondent No.3) to look into the matter and to dispose of the representation dated 29.5.2018 (Annexure P-2) expeditiously. In case the allegations leveled therein are found to be well founded then necessary steps warranted under law be taken thereupon in accordance with law at the earliest.

A copy of this order along with copy of representation Annexure P-2 be sent to the Senior Superintendent of Police, S.A.S. Nagar (respondent No.3) so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously, preferably within a period of 4 months from today.
