AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This is a petition for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.58 dated 01.07.2018 registered under Sections 365/323/148/149 IPC and Sections 25/27 of Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station City-1 Mansa, District Mansa.

The allegations in the FIR were that some persons forcibly picked up the complainant on a motor cycle and when they reached Chakoria railway crossing the petitioner along with another person was waiting in a Car. They bundled the victim in the car and took him to the fields where they given him grievous injuries and left him there.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that there is no attribution

of any injury to the petitioner. As per him the petitioner had been granted

interim bail and the same was vacated only because at that time due to some circumstances he could not get the vehicle recovered but he has clear instructions that he will immediately hand over the vehicle.

Deputy Advocate General, Punjab on instructions from ASI Gurmail Singh states that in case the petitioner is ready to hand over the vehicle his custodial interrogation is not required.

In the circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Resultantly, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating Officer on 08.02.2019 and on his so appearing and handing over the vehicle the Investigating Officer will release him on bail, to his satisfaction subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
