Present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for seeking pre-arrest bail to the petitioner(s) in case FIR No. 69 dated 19.06.2015, registered under Section(s) 307, 323, 324, 341, 506, 148 & 149 IPC at Police Station Sadar Rupnagar, District Rupnagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that petitioner had absented himself on 25.05.2017 as he had gone abroad for study purpose and subsequently, he was declared proclaimed offender on 27.02.2018. Learned counsel further contended that petitioner is ready to surrender before the

learned trial Court and face trial.
