By way of filing this petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of necessary directions to respondents No.2 to 4 so as to ensure protection of life and liberty of the petitioner and also to take appropriate action on his complaint dated 8.1.2019 (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel has submitted that his sister Paramjeet Kaur had purchased a plot in Village Kittan and that the petitioner was supervising construction upon the same but private respondents entered into the said property, armed with weapons and demolished the same. It has been submitted that although a complaint has been submitted in this regard to the police but no action has been taken thereupon.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police,

Hoshiarpur (respondent No.3) to look into the matter and to dispose of complaint dated 8.1.2019 (Annexure P-1) expeditiously. In case the allegations leveled therein are found to be well founded then necessary steps warranted under law be taken thereupon in accordance with law at the earliest.

A copy of this order along with copy of representation Annexure P-1 be sent to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur (respondent No.3) so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
