AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.27 dated 25.03.2018, registered under Section 22 of NDPS Act, 1985 at Police Station Moonak, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the co-accused of the petitioner has already been granted bail by this Court.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Mithu Ram submits that the prosecution evidence has been concluded and the matter is now fixed for defence evidence and arguments on 08.03.2019.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that though he is not in a position to unequivocally repudiate the statement yet the information which he has been given is that the prosecution evidence has not yet been concluded.

In the circumstances, it is directed that in case the prosecution evidence is not yet concluded, the trial court shall release the petitioner on bail on 08.03.2019.

Petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
