On 5.12.2018, the case was adjourned to 10.12.2018 on request of learned counsel for the petitioner. On 10.12.2018, counsel for the petitioner sought time to assist the Court whereupon the case was adjourned to 18.12.2018. On 18.12.2018, the case was adjourned on account of written request circulated on behalf of learned counsel for the petitioner. Thereafter, the case could not be taken up for hearing on 25.4.2019 and 30.07.2019, on account of counsel refraining from appearing on account of resolution passed by the Bar. On 11.9.2019, counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner requested for an adjournment on account of learned arguing counsel being out of station.

Today, none has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner nor has any request for pass over or adjournment been made despite the case having been called out twice.

In the circumstances, it appears that the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the revision petition. Accordingly, the same is dismissed for non-prosecution.
