The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.201, dated 11.10.2017, registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of the IPC, at Police Station North Chandigarh.

Learned APP states that on the last date two accused did not appear and, therefore, challan could not be filed and the matter is now fixed for 6.7.2019.

Counsel for the petitioner points out that the petitioner has now been in custody for five months and the mere fact that the other accused have not appeared cannot affect the petitioner's right for bail.

Though there is some merit in the argument of counsel for the petitioner, yet I deem it appropriate to grant one last opportunity to the State

to file the challan. It is, however, directed that whether the challan is filed or not, the petitioner be released on bail on 6.7.2019 by the trial Court to its satisfaction. The petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending C.Ms, if any, also stand disposed of.
