This is a petition for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.93 dated 05.04.2017 registered under Section 22 of NDPS Act, 1985 at Police Station Sadar Nakodar, District Jalandhar Rural.

Learned counsel states that the petitioner was regularly appearing in the Court and never misused the concession of bail and could not appear only on one day i.e. 28.11.2018 because he had wrongly noted the date as 08.12.2018 and under this impression could not appear on that date.

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Singh has accepted that the petitioner did not appear only on one date but

prior to that he had always caused appearance and had never misused the concession of bail and this one lapse can be condoned.

In the circumstances the petitioner is directed to appear before the trial Court on 15.02.2019 and the Court is directed to release him on bail to its satisfaction in case the assertion that the petitioner has not misused the concession of bail previously and that his antecedents are clean, is correct.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
