In the present writ petition, the claim being made by the petitioner is that she had served in Aided School from 1.7.1983 to 30.3.1992. Thereafter, the petitioner was selected as a JBT Teacher in the State of Haryana and she retired from the said post on 30.4.2014.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that under the Rules and Regulations, the period spent by the petitioner in Aided School is entitled to be counted as a qualifying service for the grant of pension. He further states that the petitioner has made a representation dated 30.8.2018 (Annexure P-4) to the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied in case the respondents are directed to decide the said representation in a time bound manner by passing a speaking order.

Without going into the merits of the case or expressing any opinion to the entitlement of the petitioner in respect of the claim prayed in the present writ petition or in the representation, the present writ petition is

disposed of with a direction to the respondents to pass an appropriate speaking order on the claim raised by the petitioner in the representation dated 30.08.2018 (Annexure P-4) within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case after the order, it is found by the respondents that the petitioner is entitled for any monetary benefits, the same should also be released to her within a period of next three months.

The writ petition stands disposed of.
