This is a petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for releasing detainee Noori from the illegal detention of respondent Nos.4 to 8.

Notice of motion was issued. Respondent No.3-SHO was directed to visit the house of private respondent Nos.4 to 8 and make enquiry as to whether detainee-Noori is residing there with her own consent or has been detained by the private respondents illegally and forcibly. He was also directed to submit his report in this regard.

Report by way of affidavit of Station House Officer, City Kharar, District S.A.S. Nagar (Mohali) respondent No.3 has been filed by learned State counsel, wherein it is stated that alleged detainee Noori is residing in House No.1882, Dashmesh Nagar, Naya Goan, Tehsil Kharar, District S.A.S. Nagar and she does not want to live with her husband i.e. present petitioner-Khurshid Alam. She has also levelled allegations against present petitioner-Khurshid Alam that he is filing false complaints to harass

her. The affidavit of detainee Noori is also produced on record.

Keeping in view abovesaid facts, no further action is required in this petition.

Disposed of accordingly.
